# REPORT SUMMARY

The historic Love Zimbabwe Festival, held from September 26-28, 2025, at the Zimbabwe Grounds in Harare, was a wonderful success. Organized by the Evangelical Fellowship of Zimbabwe (EFZ), the Zimbabwe Council of Churches (ZCC), the Zimbabwe Catholic Bishop's Conference (ZCBC) and the Union for the Development of Apostolic Churches in Zimbabwe (UDACIZA) in conjunction with Palau and other Christian bodies, the festival brought together thousands to celebrate faith, unity, and hope. The festival featured vibrant worship, inspiring messages, and diverse activities, uniting churches and communities across Zimbabwe in an unforgettable celebration of faith and outreach.

#### **MINISTRY WEEKS**

Prior to the Festival, from Tuesday, 9th to Thursday, 25th September, 2025, several Ministry activities took place throughout the city.

Outreaches teams went to Primary and Secondary Schools, Colleges, Universities, Eyeglass Clinics, Orphanages, and Sports Tournaments. The Women's Conference and two Affinity Dinners added some extra flair. Approximately 192,678 people were reached before the festival started.

#### **Eyeglass & Medical Clinics**

The clinics provided reading glasses along with eye exams and referrals by local doctors and student doctors, prayer and the gospel message.













#### **Eyeglass clinic highlights:**

At the four clinics hosted in Glen View, Mbare, Chitungwiza and Glen Norah, 8,759 people were seen and 2, 098 made decisions for Christ. The clinics not only provided needed reading glasses and critical referrals but also touched lives spiritually, showcasing God's love in action!

#### **Primary Schools**

Children were ministered to through various child friendly activities like BMX stunts, dances, skits, bible lessons and choreography. In partnership with AWANA, Doug Horley and many children's ministries, the goal was to help the children to know, love and serve Jesus Christ from a young age. The excitement, dancing, and worship filled the atmosphere as young lives were touched by the love of Jesus.



# Over 124,123 children were reached, and an amazing 89,605 decisions for Christ were made!











#### **Secondary Schools** -

The impact on secondary schools was profound, thanks to the incredible efforts of Kubamba Missions from Kenya, who brought energy and passion in engaging students through lively, interactive sessions. We saw students actively participate in worship, games, and discussions that opened their hearts to the message of Jesus Christ. Over 39,587 students were reached, with 9,289 making life-changing decisions to follow Christ.

We thank God for the trained children's ministry workers who played a key role in guiding the students, and express deep gratitude to the school leadership and the Ministry of Education for their support in making this possible.

#### **Universities**





Ev. Paul Saungweme brought a powerful message of HOPE to the young people! Students joined in a sports tournament. The worship and dancing was led by Kubamba and various singers. **747 Students were reached, with 289 making decisions to follow Christ.** 



#### **ORPHANAGES**

Between 22<sup>nd</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> September 2025, our team, accompanied by officers from the Department of Social Development, conducted visits to four orphanages within Harare and Chitungwiza. The purpose of the visits was to provide spiritual, emotional and material support to children living in institutional and community- based care. The reception at all four centers was warm and appreciative. The four orphanages visited include the *I Am Zimbabwe Trust*, the Maunganidze Foster Home, the Shungu DzeVana Orphanage and the Mathew Rusike Children's Home.











#### **PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES**

The Persons with Disabilities Committee, led by Br. Jimmy Sikalama from Miracle Missions had the privilege of visiting four remarkable schools—St Catherine's Special School. Batsirai Special School, Masimba Disability Support Group and Mwari Anesu Disability Support Group. These visits formed part of our ongoing commitment to evangelism, inclusion, and building lasting relationships within our community. Pastor Hamandishe, who shared from John 3:1. reminded us that because we have the love of God, we are called to share that love with others—embracing everyone without exception.

#### **AFFINITY DINNERS**

#### **Women's Dinner**

Women of influence from various industries invited friends and colleagues to an elegant dinner at the Rainbow Towers International Conference Centre. Renowned gospel singer, Janet Manyowa created a beautiful atmosphere as she sang some of Zimbabwe's favourite songs. Karen Mutasa shared inspirational stories of hope from her own life. It was amazing to see how Wendy Palau's message blended with Karen's stories to inspire all the ladies. A total of 410 women attended, and 96 made decisions for Christ, What a powerful move of God!



Wilson Smith, former head designer at Nike shoes did an incredible presentation sharing inspirational stories of how God helped him in working with famous stars like Serena Williams, Michael Jordan and others. Andrew Palau connected to some of the principles Wilson shared and shared how he came to follow Christ.











#### **Business Dinner**

The Business Leaders Evangelistic Dinner saw a remarkable turnout of Harare's business and political leaders. Over 410 attendees gathered to hear the gospel, presented in a setting designed to inspire hope and faith in the marketplace. Janet Manyowa set the tone with her beautiful songs by an inspirational testimony by Roy Chimanikire, Deputy CEO of Econet. Roy shared a touching story about his father last moments and said that it is never to late to make a decision for Christ.





The dinner provided an invaluable opportunity to reach influential figures, with 143 individuals making decisions for Christ. This demonstrates the profound impact of the event in the business and political spheres, as many left encouraged and committed to fostering godly leadership in their respective areas of influence.

#### Women's Conference

The Women's Conference in Chitungwiza saw 3000 women experience powerful moments of healing, rededication and surrender to Jesus. More than 684 women walked in droves to receive Christ as their personal Savior. "I have shared my story because if God can heal my heart, He can heal yours. If He can change my story, He can change yours too." Wendy Palau.







#### **Sports Tournaments**

The final sports tournament of the Festival took place on the morning of the first day of the Festival, featuring leading teams from earlier rounds. Youth and adult games added excitement, with trophies awarded to winning teams. In total 8,321 people listened to the gospel message at the tournaments and 811 made a commitment to follow Jesus.

#### **ACTION SPORTS**

The action sports at the Love Zimbabwe Festival were a thrilling highlight, with BMX bicycle and freestyle motocross (FMX) drawing large crowds of young people and kids.

The stunts captivated the audience, but the real impact came when these talented athletes shared how they follow Jesus in their fields. Their powerful testimonies touched the hearts of many, especially young people, who were inspired to commit their lives to Christ.


#### Preserving the harvest
